This excursion allows students to complete the practical experience needed of a 'reviewer' prior to completing the written task. Students will taste and photograph products as well as complete a workbook during the excursion as supporting materials for their assignment.

Students will meet on Aquinas lawns after lesson 6 for a uniform check. Students will walk to the venue with Mrs Sutton unless alternative arrangements have been clearly outlined in the permission form signed by parents. All students must arrive at the venue by approximately 1:50pm. Dismissal will be from the Café when the dining experience has been completed.
