As an apprentice you will:

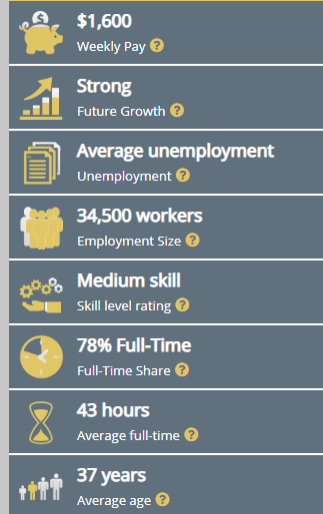
- > learn real skills in the workplace
