This summary does not include the following items:

- Co-curricular Sport team nomination fees (non-refundable)
- Co-curricular Music fee per participating student annually, to subsidise the coordination of instrumental lessons, ensembles and other music groups (non-refundable)
- Stationery requirements and books
- Laptop computer
- School uniforms
- For some activities during Community Living Week (CLW), there may be an additional charge. This will be communicated when enrolling in the activity

SIBLING DISCOUNT

Cabra offers a generous sibling discount that includes those siblings attending Catholic parish primary schools. Discounts are applied as outlined below, on the total fee, and for each sibling attending:

UPFRONT DISCOUNT

When fees are paid in full by the due date, we will continue to offer the upfront discount of 2% applied to the net tuition fee balance.

SCHOOL CARD REBATE

A tuition fee discount of 50% is provided for any family who qualifies for Department for Education (DfE) School Card scheme. It is granted to families according to guidelines set by DfE and must be applied for annually using their application forms. Guidelines for eligibility and forms are located at:

Please note the 2022 application forms may not be available on this site until December 2021 or January 2022. They are also available through the college from the dates as detailed. We recommend applying online directly with DfE.

FINANCIAL HARDSHIP VARIATIONS

Families are required to complete a fee remission form, which requests similar information to the School Card application. We will then review the information on a case-by-case basis.

FAMILIES EXPERIENCING FINANCIAL HARDSHIP

We encourage any family experiencing financial hardship to make contact with our Family Account Liaison Officer and/or the Business Manager to have a confidential discussion concerning your personal situation. We have a structured process in place whereby families can provide evidence of financial hardship to access an appropriate level of financial support.

STUDENTS LEAVING

- When a student leaves, the family must provide the College one term's notice. An Admin Fee of \$500 will be applied when this notice is not given. Tuition fees will be adjusted to reflect the number of weeks tuition is provided for the year.

ABSENCES

- Payment of school fees is still required where a student is absent from school for any length of time.
- A student who temporarily leaves the college for a minimum of a term and wishes to return to the college will pay a holding fee of at least 50% of the fees applicable during the student's absence.

VET COURSES AND OTHER EXTERNAL STUDIES

Students may undertake Vocational Education and Training (VET) courses or study other subjects not offered by the college (e.g. Open Access, School of Languages) and earn the credits required to achieve their SACE.

Parents/caregivers are responsible for the payment of any external studies.

If the VET course is undertaken as:

- an alternative to a SACE subject offered at Cabra, (i.e. not as an additional subject)

then the College will contribute to the fee for the VET course up to \$1,000 for the equivalent of one course for a semester. Once the invoice has been received from the external provider Cabra will pay the invoice directly then charge families on their fee account the excess of the course cost.

- an addition to SACE subjects, (i.e., the student maintains a FULL load plus a VET course)

then the full cost of the VET course will be charged to the family.

PART TIME STUDENTS

An adjustment to fees for part-time students will only be made if a student has reduced their subject load significantly, and at the discretion of the Principal, the Director of Learning and Teaching and/or the Business Manager.

FEE PAYMENT METHOD

Each family is required to enter into an annual payment plan for their total tuition fees. Ensuring fees are paid in a timely manner enables Cabra to provide the highest level of education, support and service to your child(ren) and family.

Payments options include:

A) Periodic Payment Plan

- Weekly (x 52)
- Fortnightly (x 26)
- Monthly (x 12)

Payments are spread over the entire year, from January through to December; or

B) Upfront Discount

Cabra offers a 2% discount for the full payment of your net total tuition fee account if paid by Friday 25 February 2022.

Payments can be made via:

- Credit Card
- Direct Debit; or
- BPay

SPLIT FEE ACCOUNTS

Family accounts will only be split if a court order is in place specifying how fees are to be paid.

Family accounts will be billed as per the enrolment form. Where this represents a separated family the college expects the enrolling parents/caregivers to arrange payment plans between themselves ensuring all fees are up to date at the end of the year.

DEBT COLLECTION

Our college is committed to working with every family to support the education of their children at Cabra. We understand that families have different financial circumstances where we work with them to negotiate fee payments which are fair and equitable to all parties (the college and the family). The effectiveness of our approach depends on the mutual ongoing commitment and regular communication for any changes in circumstances.

When a family is unresponsive to the reasonable efforts from the College to collect fees and charges owing, it may refer the account to a debt collection service. All associated costs will be borne by the family as per the terms and conditions on the enrolment application process. Where there is a change in circumstance of a relationship status, parties who are signatories will still be liable jointly and severally for their tuition fee account.
