Term 2 Student Learner Conversations

The College acknowledges the primary role of parents and families in student learning and recognises them as valued partners in the learning process. The upcoming Student Learner Conversations are an opportunity for parents and families to engage with staff at the College to ensure the best for each individual student.

Student Learner Conversations take place on Monday 5 May from 2:00pm to 7:00pm (face-to-face in Caleruega Hall) and on Monday 12 May from 4:00pm to 6:00pm (via telephone to Parent/Caregiver Contact 1). **Students must be in attendance** and are expected to be involved in these conversations.

Student Learner Conversations will focus on learning, and how your child can continue to grow and succeed in their subjects. The Student Learner Conversation is not a time to discuss, in detail, major learning difficulties – this may best be left for a separate occasion where there is more time available.

Note: Students will be dismissed at 1:00pm on Monday 5 May and at the usual dismissal time of 3:15pm on Monday 12 May. The Monica Farrelly Atrium will close at **4:00pm** on both days.

Winter Uniform

All students are expected to show pride in themselves and the College by meeting requirements related to uniform and presentation. Such self-respect is the first step towards mutual respect, something we value as one of our Cabra Principles for Working Together.

As Term 1 comes to a close and the weather becomes cooler, it is timely to remind students and parents that the Winter Uniform is to be worn from the start of Term 2. This includes the wearing of the blazer to and from school. I ask parents to support the College <u>Uniform and Personal Presentation Policy</u> by ensuring that students have the required uniform, and that it is worn neatly and correctly, as outlined in the <u>Cabra Handbook</u> (p. 17 – 18).

School Photography | Ordering Photographs

We are pleased to be partnering with <u>advancedlife</u> for our 2025 class, individual and sibling photos on Monday 12 May. Students are required to wear their formal winter uniform, including blazers, and bring their PE uniform to change into if relevant.

Ordering: The ordering method is **online**. Please follow these payment instructions:

- Go to <u>www.advancedlife.com.au</u> and enter the 9-digit ordering code: **7A7 485 BWK** and click **SUBMIT**.
- 2. Select **ORDER PHOTOS** from the menu to order this year's packages.
- 3. Enter the first student's details you wish to order for and click **PROCEED**.
- 4. Use the **SELECT** check box for the package(s) you wish to purchase.
- 5. List the quantity required and **ADD TO CART.** Note: If you enter incorrect student details, select **EDIT STUDENT DETAILS.**
- 6. If you only wish to order for one child, please proceed to CHECKOUT.
- 7. Check that the item in your cart is correct and click **CHECKOUT** to finalise your order or click **CONTINUE SHOPPING** to add an order for another student.
- 8. Check your order carefully, as refunds will not be given for incorrect choice.
- 9. Enter your payment details and click **PAY**. A 1.5% merchant fee is applicable for this service unless you pay via Latitude Pay.
- 10. A receipt for your payment and order will be sent to the email address provided.

Note: The online payment system works best using Google Chrome on a computer. If having trouble paying, please use this method.

Sibling Photos: Photos may be ordered online using the 9-digit code. **Online orders for sibling/family photos will be cut off at midnight on the day prior to photography**. Sibling photographs are only to include children enrolled at Cabra Dominican College.

Late Orders: All orders after the main day of photography must be made online. To order online you will need to enter the 9-digit ordering code. Orders can be made for up to a week after the main day of photography at regular pricing. After the week, all orders are closed, and the order will incur a reorder fee. This fee cannot be waived. advancedlife offers a 100% money back guarantee on their products to ensure peace of mind. Families of Cabra students who are intending to visit Kawagoe next year or in future years are encouraged to host a student this year. This will enable our students to establish friendships and connections and develop a greater sense of intercultural awareness in preparation for a future visit to Kawagoe in Japan. Students who participated in the exchange last year are also encouraged to host. Naturally, some families may also wish to host a visiting student without committing to any future exchange or trip

To obtain a Working with Children Check, follow these steps:

- 1. Visit the SA Government WWCC Website
- 2. Click on Apply for a Screening Check
- 3. Click on the green Start Now button
- 4. When filling out the Application details for the Role Description, write *Hosting an overseas high school student*
- 5. Check the Working with Children Check box under the Screenings Required
- 6. The applicant type is Volunteer
