Our Japanese sister school study trip program continues in 2025, with students from Kawagoe Minami High School visiting Cabra from **Wednesday 23 July – Saturday 2 August.** We are asking Cabra Dominican College families to host our visiting Japanese students for the duration of their stay. We have a long and very special relationship with Kawagoe Minami High School, with many wonderful friendships formed over the years between visiting students and host families from Cabra.

Families of Cabra students who are intending to visit Kawagoe next year or in future years are encouraged to host a student this year. This will enable our students to establish friendships and connections and develop a greater sense of intercultural awareness in preparation for a future visit to Kawagoe in Japan. Students who participated in the exchange last year are also encouraged to host. Naturally, some families may also wish to host a visiting student without committing to any future exchange or trip

To obtain a Working with Children Check, follow these steps:

- 1. Visit the SA Government WWCC Website
- 2. Click on Apply for a Screening Check
- 3. Click on the green Start Now button
- 4. When filling out the Application details for the Role Description, write *Hosting an overseas high school student*
- 5. Check the Working with Children Check box under the Screenings Required
- 6. The applicant type is Volunteer
