## Managing COVID-19 and Influenza Positive Cases

Winter can bring increased risks of illness (e.g., colds, flu and gastro).

- COVID-19: Students showing COVID-19 symptoms should stay away from school until acute symptoms (runny nose, sore throat, cough and fever) have cleared (usually 5 to 7 davs).
- Influenza: Students with influenza and influenza-like illnesses should stay away from school until well (at least 7 – 10 days for students).

Students can reduce the risk of getting sick of passing infections on to others by washing their hands (particularly after going to the toilet or handling used tissues) and covering their coughs and sneezes with a tissue.
